



MEMORANDUM of UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

BUREAU OF METROLOGY (BoM) OF THE REPUBLIC OF MACEDONIA

The Bureau of Metrology, hereafter BoM, created by the Law on Metrology ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Macedonia" no. 55/02, 84/07, 120/09, 136/11, 06/12, 164/13 and 41/14), as the legal entity respnosible for implementation of the Law on Metrology, the Law on Control on articles of precious metals ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Macedonia" no. 23/95, 22/07, 136/11 and 164/13) and the Law on vehicles ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Macedonia" no. 140/08), headquartered in Skopje - Blvd. Jane Sandanski 109a, herein represented by it's Director MSc. Dimitar Parnardziev.
